Using the Dry Vacuum Cleaner

- Do not use the cleaner without the bag fitted
- Switch off and unplug before emptying or changing the bag.
- Do not empty the waste or bag onto a fire it may explode.
- 4. Plan your route to avoid running over the cable.
- If you think the cable may be cut or damaged in any way, switch off and unplug at the mains before inspecting it. If the cable attached to the vacuum cleaner is damaged, stop using the equipment. Contact the hire company. If an extension cable has been damaged, do not use it again.
- Take care not to accidentally pull the plug from the socket.
- Switch off and remove the plug from the socket before leaving the machine
- If your equipment does not work properly do not attempt to repair it. Contact the
